FAMILIES IN NEED OF SERVICES

132 *HB282* *Champagne* Reauthorizes the early intervention program for at-risk children and their families

TRAFFIC

275 *HB176* *Pope* Permits a child who is in at least the ninth grade and is less than 15 years of age to participate in the classroom instruction component of the driver education program operated by BESE and the state Dept. of Education

DELINQUENCY

158 *HB 211* *Thibaut* Provides for the maintenance of juvenile fingerprints

213 *HB565* *Ernst* Provides with respect to informal adjustment agreements

100 *HB701* *Thibaut* Provides for establishment and maintenance of juvenile justice programs and services

230 *SB61* *Heitmeier* Allows the Department of Health and Hospitals, upon court order, to use restraints on certain children during transport

253 *SB302* *Broome* Provides for the conversion of Jetson Center for Youth

379 *HB628* *Landry* Provides for the delays for certain child custody orders

378 *HB600* *Johnson* Provides for the determination of income for support purposes

284 *HB319* *Willmott* Provides relative to instruction to certain students in public secondary schools concerning the state's safe haven relinquishments law

142 *HB545* *Ritchie* Requires certain principals to provide for transfer of certain student education records

240	<i>SB223</i>	<i>Claitor</i>	Provides relative to the removal of students from the classroom for certain inappropriate behavior and for parental notification and involvement
246	<i>SB259</i>	<i>Kostelka</i>	Provides for the high school career option program
257	<i>SB316</i>	<i>Nevers</i>	Provides for comprehensive approach to improve graduation rates and ensure college and career readiness for high school students

354	<i>SB282</i>	<i>Hebert</i>	Provides for a consumer health provider information system
251	<i>SB294</i>	<i>Nevers</i>	Transfers the regulation of medical psychologists from the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists to the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners

90	<i>HB266</i>	<i>Hazel</i>	Amends the crime of domestic abuse battery
283	<i>HB274</i>	<i>Templet</i>	Increases penalties for battery and for assault of a school teacher
58	<i>HB310</i>	<i>Hazel</i>	Amends elements of the crime of computer-aided solicitation of a minor
205	<i>HB366</i>	<i>Wooton</i>	Provides relative to monitoring of sex offenders
210	<i>HB476</i>	<i>Connick</i>	Provides relative to the protection of children
375	<i>HB564</i>	<i>Abramson</i>	Creates the crime of trafficking of children for sexual purposes
302	<i>HB688</i>	<i>Montoucet</i>	Creates the crime of unlawful disruption of the operation of a school
192	<i>SB94</i>	<i>Donahue</i>	Creates the crime of molestation of a juvenile involving an educator

400 *SB145* *Crowe* Creates the crime of "unauthorized use of a wireless router system" for the purpose of downloading, uploading, or selling pornography involving juveniles

3 *HB140* *Chaney* Provides for the relationship of parent and child

182 *HB244* *Roy* Amends provisions of law regarding drug court

166 *HB499* *Monica* To require all passengers in a vehicle to wear a seat belt

427 *HB629* *Landry* Provides relative to delays for the hearing of certain temporary restraining orders

221 *HB703* *Katz* Authorizes the Dept. of Social Services to conduct criminal background checks on certain persons

382 *HB755* *Edwards* Provides relative to victims of child pornography

47 *HB784* *Katz* Requires the Department of Social Services to search the central registry of justified abuse and neglect to assess potential employees of the department who would be working with children

311 *HB834* *Stiaes* Provides relative to Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists

438 *HB852* *Smiley* Abolishes boards and commissions and like entities

195 *SB32* *Chaisson* Authorizes St. John the Baptist to expend funds from a previously levied one mill, 20-year tax for construction and/or renovation of a facility to house the juvenile probation officers, judges, counselors and other personnel associated with juvenile services

400 *SB137* *L.Jackson* Transfers the functions related to the licensure of child care institutions and agencies from the secretary of the Department of Social Services to the office of community services within the Department of Social Services

343 *SB171* *Broome* Requires a licensed child care facility to provide information to parents about the benefits of immunizing certain children against influenza

241 *SB230* *Shaw* Provides procedures for the implementation of certain family and child support programs

94 *SB238* *Mount* Provides for licensing and regulation of child day care facilities and child placing agencies by the Department of Social Services

351 *SB251* *Erdey* Requires day care facilities to provide parents with reports issued by the Department of Social Services

83 *SB260* *Claitor* Provides for the jurisdiction of the East Baton Rouge Parish Family Court
